I am planning to setup this small webserver of mine (only 3-5 websites) on your regular VPS plans, using the lifetime DA license of my own. This means having to setup DA on my side with all the additions on a clean install of CentOS.

Is this allowed in general? Also, how does the disk space calculations go about from here? Is the amount shown in your VPS value plan the total space available for the DA install and usable space for websites/etc. I understand that various installations of CentOS 6 are available, each with varying amount of disk use, does this count into the actual given disk space use too?

In comparison, for your DA plans is the available space purely for webspace (i.e exclusive of the DA installation space).
